Sewing and Alterations	Sew, fit and repair costumes
Props	Make and obtain props
Set Painting	Paint set and scenery - no artistic talents required
Costume Accessories	Make accessories - usually involves cutting, gluing and hand sewing

Tasks completed the week of or during the performance

Movement of Sets from Storage / Studio to Stage	Assist with moving and setting up sets
Make-up Prior to Performance	Apply make-up prior to start of performance
Make-up During the Performance	Apply make-up during the performance
Dresser	Assist with quick costume changes
Tech Crew	Assist back stage with moving sets, tech cues, etc.
Merchandise Table	Set up merchandise table, staff the table before performance, during intermission, after the performance. Take down the table and store merchandise.
Steamer	Steam costumes prior to dress rehearsal and performance
Usher	Collect tickets and distribute programs
Dressing Room Monitor / Boys	Assist with last minute details; maintain quiet; cue upcoming dances
Dressing Room Monitor / Girls	Assist with last minute details; maintain quiet; cue upcoming dances

Tasks completed after the performance

Laundering of Costumes	Take costumes home to launder and return to storage
Movement of Sets from Stage to Storage / Studio	Assist with breaking sets and moving sets from the stage

Other tasks completed throughout the season

Coordinate Costumes for Community Events	Distribute costumes to volunteers to transport to/from events
Office Assistance	Update spreadsheets, assist with emails, other clerical tasks
